

ERRBL - Directions to Neighboring Town's Ball Diamonds

NEZ Bantams ONLY! (Lakers, Bandits, Cougars) Edmonton Rundle Park

- 2909 – 113 Avenue Edmonton
- South off of 118 Avenue at the Rundle Park turnoff to the ball diamonds on the left side of the road about 1 mile down.

NEZ Midgets ONLY! Edmonton Spartan Ball Park

- Just one ½ block South of Fort Road at 65 Street
- Turn North on 66 street if coming down the Yellowhead Trail. Cross the tracks and look right just after the underpass it should be visible from there. Turn down the alley just before Fort Road.

Edmonton St. Anne's

- 14105-94 Street Edmonton in Northmount Park
- Just a few blocks North of 97 Street.

Edmonton Abbotsfield

- 34 Street – Abbotsfield Road
- North on 34 Street off of 118 Avenue to Abbotsfield Road.
- Turn right towards the diamond.

Edmonton South Jasper Place

- Collingwood Place
- 178 Street and 76 Ave (approximately).
- Take the Yellowhead Trail to 170 Street and go South to 118 Avenue
- Take 118th Avenue West to 178th Street, then go South to Collingwood (76 Avenue)
- Take a left at the Esso to Collingwood Park.

Spruce Grove

- Take the Yellowhead Trail to Century Road overpass
- Travel South through town crossing Hwy 16A & train tracks
- 1st intersection past tracks should be a Tee intersection. There should be a Hugh's Petroleum on one of the corners. Turn right at this Tee, go West towards Home Hardware.
- The ball diamonds should be just across the street from home hardware

Stony Plain

- Hwy 16A West to Stony Plain
- Thru to the 48 Street off ramp, go South.
- South to 53 Avenue then turn right (West)
- 53 Avenue (West) to the park (Centennial Park)
- You will come to a T intersection, make a left turn
- You can park in the arena parking lot or go down and park in front of the Stony Plain Swimming Pool
- Arena #3 is located behind the swimming pool

Leduc

- Fred Johns Park Res #1
- 2A south to Hwy 39 intersection
- Turn left (South) into Fred Johns Park
- Res # 1 , which is farthest from the highway.

St. Albert – Legion Memorial Park

- 215 Sturgeon Road
- Hwy 2 North (St. Albert Trail) to Sir Winston Churchill Avenue, turn right (East)
- East on Winston Churchill Avenue to Boudreau Road, turn left (North)
- North on Boudreau Road to Sturgeon Road, turn right (East)
- East to Legion Memorial Park

St. Albert – Bellerose

- 49 Giroux Road
- Hwy 2 North (St. Albert Trail) to Giroux Road (North end of St. Albert across from Hospital), turn left (West)
- West on Giroux Road to Bellerose Composite High School, turn right (North) into parking lot
- Diamond is behind the school

Tofield

- Take Highway 14 East
- About 40 km out of Sherwood Park you will turn left off the highway in to Tofield
- Take the second left on that road
- Go over the railroad tracks and turn right immediately
- Take the third left (fields can be seen on the right as soon as you turn)
- Diamond #2 is the baseball field

Strathcona Bantams - Ardrossan

- Take hwy 16 East about 5 miles past the Hwy 21 (Fort Sask) turn off
- Stay on Hwy 16 about 1 mile past the Esso station. Take the exit South into town
- Continue South through town all the way through till just before the railway tracks. Turn left in front of the tracks
- You will see a hockey arena and curling rink on the left hand side
- The ball park is just behind the curling rink.

Strathcona Midgets - Ardrossan

- Take Hwy 16 East about 5 miles past the Hwy 21 (Fort Sask) turn off
- Stay on Hwy 16 about 1 mile past the Esso station. Take the exit South into town
- Continue South through town to “Holy Redeemer School”, it is diamond #2

Wetaskiwin

- Hwy 2A South to the Hwy 13 intersection (lights)
- Turn left (East) towards Camrose, past the hospital to the business park.
- Look for Home Hardware distribution center – turn right (South)
- Continue South for about ½ mile to the end of the parking lot.
- Go right at the end of the parking lot to the “Knights of Columbus” diamonds

Sherwood Park Bantams – Sherwood Heights #1

- 241 Fir Street
- Take Hwy 14 to the Wye Road turn off. Head East into Sherwood Park.
- Turn left on Sherwood Drive (just after the London drugs)
- Go about ½ block, turn right on Fir Street.
- Stay on Fir Street for about (6) blocks till you see the Mount Olivet Lutheran Church
- Turn right in the first driveway past the church
- The bantam ball diamond is just east of the batting cage

Sherwood Park Bantams – Salisbury #1

- Sherwood Drive just past Oak Street
- Take Hwy 16 East to Hwy 14
- Take Hwy 14 to the Wye Road turn off. Head East into Sherwood Park.
- Turn left on Sherwood Drive (just after the London Drugs)
- Continue thru 2 lights, stay to the right at the traffic circle
- Continue on Strathcona Drive, past Oak Street and it's the first driveway on the left past the fire hall

Sherwood Park Midgets - Strathcona Athletic Park – SAP #4 Colwell Blvd

- Colwell Blvd and Calico Drive
- Take Hwy 16 East to Cloverbar Road, go South
- Continue South and go over Baseline Road
- Turn right at Colwell Blvd
- Parking lot is first left

Sherwood Park Midgets - Strathcona Athletic Park – SAP #1

- Behind Bev Facey High School
- Take Hwy 16 East to Cloverbar Road, go South
- Continue South and go over Baseline Road
- Turn right at Colwell Blvd
- Continue around Colwell until you come to 1st left after the baseball diamond
- Go to the back of the parking lot and Diamond #1 is to the South of the parking lot behind the school

Waskatenau – Pine Creek Ball Park

- From Edmonton – Manning Freeway to Hwy 28A turnoff (turns into Hwy 28).
- North on 28A past Gibbons, Redwater & Radway to Waskatenau (about 90 kms).
- From Sherwood Park – North on Hwy 21 through Ft. Sask. To SH 831 at Lamont.
- Turn left north on SH 831 and continue North for about 40 kms, to Hwy 28.
- Go East on Hwy 28 for about 1 km.
- 52 Street & 52 Avenue

Devon – Bantam diamond

- On Hwy 19 just East of Hwy 60. Diamond #16

Beaumont

- Four Seasons Park – Diamond #2
- Located behind Beaumont Composite High School
- Coming from Edmonton on 50th Street (Hwy 814)
- Turn right at 43 Avenue (bottom of the hill)
- Continue on 43 Avenue until you see the igh school on the left hand side
